The building consists of 169 square metres of office with a fumigating room for the treatment of church documents and 450 square metres of warehouse divided in two, with half being a special atmosphere controlled archive area for the storing of delicate and old books, documents and religious objects, this area will be constructed from a fire retardant sandwich panel inside a 150mm concrete panel construction.
